



Calgary Rowing Club
Boat Storage Agreement

The purpose of this agreement is to set forth the terms and conditions under which the Calgary Rowing Club will allow club members the privilege of storing their boat in the club's premises.

Since there is a limited amount of space available for private boats, the CRC will attempt to allocate the storage area in a manner that is fair and reasonable to those concerned members.

The "CRC" and "Club" and "Board of Directors" may have the same meaning.

General Guidelines

The following guidelines will serve as reference in allocating boat storage space:

1. In order to be eligible for storage space the person must be an "Annual" or "Lifetime" member in good standing of the Club.
2. The fee for storage may be determined from time to time by the Board of Directors.
3. The fee will cover the membership fiscal year of May 1 to April 30.
4. The responsibility for insurance of individual boats and oars shall be that of the owner of the boat.
5. The CRC will not be liable for any damage inflicted on boats while in storage.
6. A waiting list of names will be established, in chronological order, to accumulate persons interested in storage space after all available storage space has been taken.
7. Storage space for private boats may be determined from time to time in order that sufficient space will be available for club use. The Club will recover storage space based on the "last in first out" basis. Any refunds will be prorated. That member will then be placed in the number one position on the waiting list.
8. The non-payment of membership fees and storage fees by May 1 will result in thirty (30) day grace period. Afterwards, the member will be asked to remove their boat within 48 hours. Failure to do so will allow the CRC to remove the boat from the boat shelf and/or the premises.
9. Any person failing to pay the required membership dues within the grace period will be placed at the back of the waiting list. Consequently, the first name on the list will get a storage space.
10. The Club may under special circumstances allow a non-member to store their boat on a temporary basis. If the Club requires space then the non-member will be required to give up their space.
11. Any members wishing to exchange boat storage space amongst themselves must notify the Board.
12. Failure by a boat owner to complete and submit this form to the CRC will result in the forfeiture of any entitlement to store a boat on CRC property.
