The University of Calgary Rowing Club will be hosting its annual Head of the Weasel Regatta on Saturday October 4, 2008. All activities will be coordinated from the CRC boathouse in North Glenmore Park. Currently this is not a sanctioned event.

The Regatta will be in head race format. The course will be approximately 5 km in length starting at the Glenmore Causeway and winding around the waters of the Calgary reservoir. Note: The course will be determined based on water conditions on the day of the regatta.

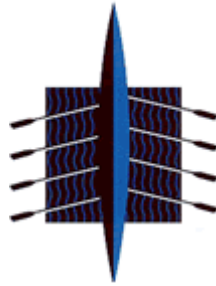
This regatta is focused on participation. The regatta has been planned for two launches according to the enclosed entry form with launch schedule; we are willing to make adjustments to maximize participation.

Entries

- Due on October 2, 2008 by 6:00 pm. Adjustments may be made to the schedule pending entries
- Entry fee is \$15 per person. Please make cheques payable to the University of Calgary Rowing Club.
- No limit to number of entries per club or per launch. Intent of regatta is to maximize participation.
- Results are based on % relative to Rowing Canada's Gold Medal Standard. Masters will be given a 2% adjustment for each "age" classification. I.E Master A receive + 2%, Master B + 4% Master C 6% and so on to their overall %.
- Coaches meeting will be at 9:30 am on Saturday at the boathouse to be followed by a general address to the participating athletes reviewing the course, schedule and safety issues.
